# Site Information

Reception	9am to 10.30am / 2pm to 8pm. Local information, games, DVD's, books - available to borrow.
Arrival/Departure	Lodges: Arrival between 4pm – 8pm. Vacate by 10am. Camping (Tent Pitches / Hard Standing): Arrival between 2pm – 8pm. Vacate by 11am. Log Pods: Arrival between 2pm – 8pm. Vacate by 10am.
Communication	WIFINo code needed. Connect to the 'Bunroy Park' network. Connection speed not guaranteed and use of the network is at owner's risk.Mobile SignalMost mobile phone network providers offer a minimum of 4G/LTE signal. Satellite/Aerial signal is dependent on your equipment and location on the site.
Drains / Toilets Laundry	DO NOT flush anything other than toilet paper down the toilet. Washing/drying machines are located on the end of the shower block; please see map for details. DO NOT put dirty laundry in the dryer.
Rubbish	The waste bins are located by the welcome sign on the entrance/exit to the park please see the sitemap. Please use the correct bin and help us recycle.
Wildlife	We ask that you be respectful to the local wildlife. Human food can be detrimental to their health.
Fishing	You may fish at the bottom of the Park on the River Spean, fly or spinner only.
Fridge and freezer	Fridge freezer for campers use is in the laundry room. Please make sure your name is on food items in the fridge. All items not named will be discarded.
Calor/Campingaz	These may be obtained from reception during normal office hours.
Shower block	Cleaned daily and checked regularly. Please let us know if anything needs our attention.
Evacuation Plan	Please make yourself familiar with our evacuation point in case of any unforeseen emergency. In case of emergency, please remain calm and follow instruction from staff.
First Aid	There is a first aid kit available at reception for your use. Please note there is no first aider on site.

## **Park Policies**

Speed Limit	The site speed limit is <u>10 mph</u> for the safety of all.	
Litter	Keep the scene clean!	
Fires	No open fires or burning of wood is allowed anywhere on the site. We are in a high risk area.	
Barbeques	<b>No barbeques directly on the grass</b> – please ensure that your barbeque or unshielded gas burner is raised 30cm to avoid scorching the grass. <b>Do not put hot coal in the bins.</b>	
REMEMBER CARBON MONOXIDE KILLS! NEVER USE A BARBEQUE IN YOUR TENT OR AWNING		
Noise	To be kept at a modest and reasonable level at all times and to an <u>absolute minimum</u> between 1 0:00pm and 08:00am. If someone else's noise is disturbing you, please let us know.	
Dogs	Welcome but <b>must be kept on a lead at all times and must not be allowed to foul the site</b> . There are walks through the woodland and along the riverbank to exercise them.	
Ground sheets	Please lift your ground sheets regularly to avoid killing the grass.	
Ball games	If playing ball games please ensure that you don't disturb other guests or damage property, we ask that	
	you use the lower half of the field behind the Log Pods.	
Children	Children should be supervised by a responsible adult at all times. Please ensure that children and vulnerable adults are aware of the dangers of the roads and the river.	
Bicycles:	Bicycles may be ridden, max speed <b>5mph</b> in the park with care and consideration. Appropriate safety equipment should be worn. The owner takes <b>No Responsibility</b> for any loss/damage/injury/expense. Unregistered motor vehicles are not permitted in the Park at any time except for disability use.	
Accommodation	Please leave lodges and pods clean and tidy. Accommodation left in an unreasonable condition or damaged will incur an additional charge. <b>Our lodges &amp; pods are all Smoke and Pet Free</b> and will incur an additional cleaning charge if smoking odours are detected.	
Evictions	The Park reserves the right to evict anyone who makes or created a problem in the Park, giving the said person or persons one (1) hour to vacate their site/lodge/pod/pitch.	
Insurance	The owner takes no responsibility for any loss/damage/injury/expense to belongings or persons however caused whilst on the park. Please ensure you are adequately insured.
